You will not know what your question will be. **This project is due Friday, February 13.**

Personal Ad Video or Skit (50%): For this part of your project you have the option of performing a live personal ad or creating a video. The video/skit should be no more than three minutes and no less than one minute. The person ad needs to include the following:

1. What type of farmer you are.
2. A summary of the type of farming you do.
3. Location, location, location: Where you and other farmers like you located?



4. How do you make your money? Do you make a lot?
5. What types of crops do you farm?
6. What makes you a good catch?



A typed skit for either your video or actual skit will need to be turned in as part of your project. You may use props and PowerPoint backdrops. If you do a skit, it will need to be well rehearsed.
