India: Background

- 1. India was part Hindu and part Muslim
- 2. Muslims built Taj Mahal
- 3. India was rich in spices and natural resources
- 4. India was colonized by Great Britain
- 5. Indians have a caste-based society

Early Attempts at Independence

- 1. INC (Indian National Congress) leads movement for independence
- 2. Mostly a Hindu organization
- 3. INC led by Mohandas Gandhi
- 4. Gandhi promotes civil disobedience and passive resistance
- 5. Goal is to rebel without violence

Muslims Left Out

- 1. Muslims don't trust INC
- 2. Create Muslim League
- 3. Muslims monotheistic
- 4. Hindus polytheistic
- 5. Extremely different beliefs

Solutions

- 1. Britain sets India free
- 2. Partition India into 2 countries
- 3. Creates India (Hindu)
- 4. Creates Pakistan (Muslim)
- 5. West and East Pakistan

Ceylon freed; becomes Sri Lanka

Modern India

- 1. Gandhi dies, India led by Nehru
- 2. Nehru westernizes India
- 3. New constitution prohibits caste discrimination
- 4. East Pakistan becomes Bangladesh
- 5. India now a growing democracy
- 6. Use federal system (like US) to give power to states
