
Origins of the Industrial Revolution

- 2. Used for \$\$ mercantilism
- 3. Rigid social hierarchy
- 4. Forced conversions
- Colonies provide materials and labor



Revolutions

- 1. Haiti and L'Ouverture
- 2. Mexico and Hidalgo
- 3. South America and Bolivar
- 4. US and Monroe Doctrine
- 5. Europeans lost colonies forever

Back in Europe...

- 1. Europeans must make their own \$ and products
- 2. Will go through an Industrial Revolution
- 3. Industrial = making things (manufacturing)
- 4. Revolution = sudden change



Where?

- L. Begins in England in early 1800s
- 2. England lost US as a colony first
- 3. Already went through Agricultural Revolution
- 4. More food = more people





- 1. England started Enclosure Movement
- 2. Make land and farms privately owned
- 3. People work harder for their own
- 4. Produce more and more food/resources



Why Else?

- 1. England has resources (coal, iron ore, timber)
- 2. England has international markets (\$\$)
- 3. England had the capital (\$\$) to spend
- 4. England had some industry already (textiles, iron)
