<u>Axum</u>

- Located near the **Ethiopian Highlands** and **Nile River**
- Ruled by a king
- Were **monotheistic** (believed in one supreme god)
- Practiced <u>animism</u> (belief that spirits inhabit everything)
- Later converted to <u>Christianity</u>
- Had a written language
- Used **terrace** farming and **irrigation** systems

Ghana

- Located near the **Niger River** and **Sahara Desert**
- Ruled by a king
- Economy based on the **gold-salt trade** on the **Trans-Saharan** trade route
- Practiced animism and Islam

<u>Mali</u>

- Located near the **Niger River** and **Sahara Desert**
- Ruled by a **emperor**, named **Mansa Musa**
- Economy based on the **gold-salt trade** on the **Trans-Saharan** trade route
- Practiced Islam
- Capital city was <u>**Timbuktu**</u> were many <u>**mosques**</u> and <u>**universities**</u> were built

Songhai

- Located near the **Niger River** and **Sahara Desert**
- Capital city was **Gao**
- Ruled by a king
- Economy based on the **gold-salt trade** on the **Trans-Saharan** trade route
- Practiced Islam

Zimbabwe

- Located near the **Zambezi** and **Limpopo** Rivers
- Ruled by a king
- Capital city was **Great Zimbabwe**
