King of Macedon.
Conquered most of

ALEXANDER THE GREAT: (336 BC - 323 BC)

- * Son of Phillip II
- * Finished what his father started
- * Became the most powerful man in the world at the time
- * His empire stretched from Greece to Egypt and to the western border of India
- * Spread "Hellenistic" culture (combination of Greek and Oriental cultures) as his empire grew
- * Hellenistic culture spread quickly through trade throughout the Mediterranean region
